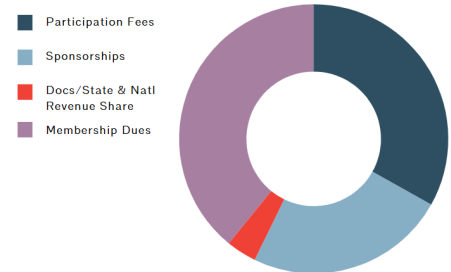

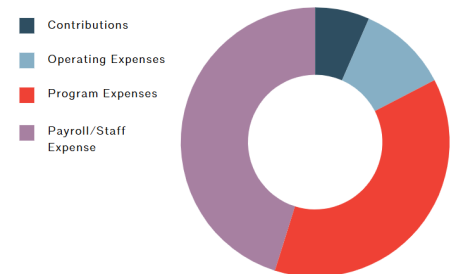
Income By Source YTD

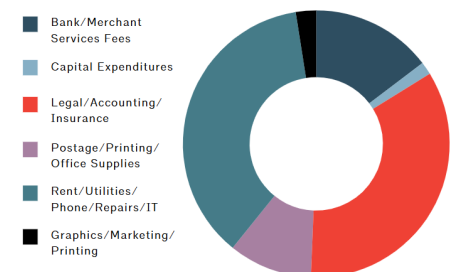

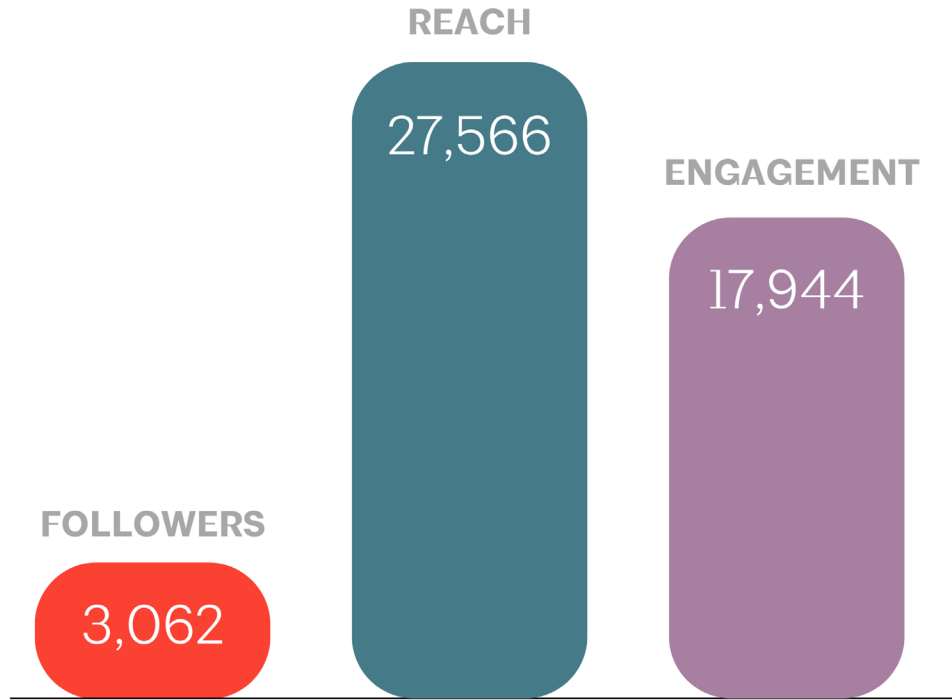

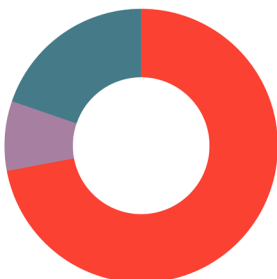

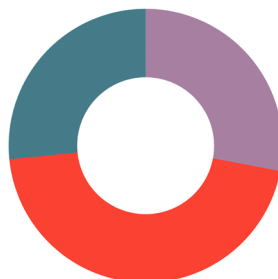

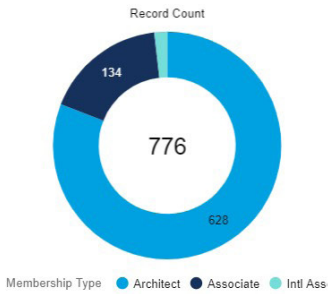

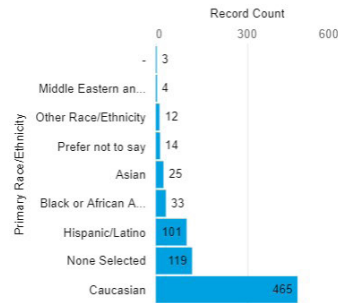

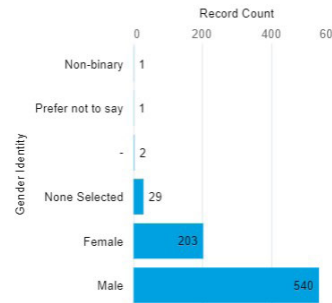

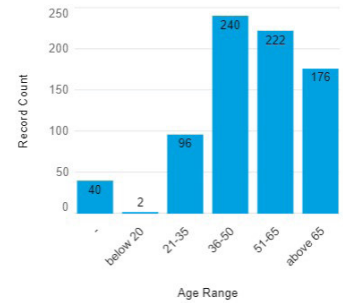
Active Members by Race/Ethnicity
